

RULES

Anyone entering or using the Hawker Pavilion facilities (inside and out) are doing so at their own risk and agree to hold harmless Grande Prairie Regional College, Fairview Agricultural Society, or volunteers and employees of any of the above entities.

Management is considered representatives of Fairview Agricultural Society.

Riders must have insurance through AEF

Arena management has the right to refuse anyone entry to the Hawker Pavilion facility or refuse rental of the facility to a person or a group.

It is each owner's/rider's responsibility to ensure their horse is free from sickness/disease. Management has the right to refuse entry to any horse that isn't in proper health or is deemed undesirable

No smoking in any building or storage facility

No alcohol

All persons using/attending Hawker Pavilion facilities shall obey any/all notices posted on the premises

All riders must sign the Liability Waiver prior to entering the arena

Thoroughly clean up after your horse whether it is on the cement pad, barn alley, or in the parking area

If your horse urinates on the cement pad put shavings on it and then clean them up

No feeding horses in the wash rack

No tying of your horse inside the arena. Horses are to be tied on the north cement pad only

Do not utilize any of the stalling without management's approval

No horses past the west end of the stalls or tied on the NE corner by the horse door

All gates to the arena must be closed while riding

Horses will exit the arena only from the NE gate

No turning horses loose in the arena if there are horses tied to the fence or inside the arena

While horses are on the cement, there is no sitting on them.

All incidents must be reported to management

All dogs must be on leash

Farrier work is in the designated farrier area only. This space must be pre-booked by the farrier. No other indoor space will be provided.

If you want to lunge your horse and there are already people using the arena please ask their permission prior to entering. Please stay at the middle of one end of the arena – no more than one horse being lunged at a time

Children must be supervised at all times or be placed in the children's play area.

Barrels/jumps/poles or other objects can only be placed in the arena during specified riding times or at the approval of management

Any obstacles use must be put away completely after use – this includes collapsing the pop up barrels

Youth 12 & Under must wear a helmet

Proper foot wear must be worn while riding

16 and under cannot handle a stallion

Horses must be under control at all times. You may be asked to leave the arena if your horse is endangering the property, or other people or their horses.

Various disciplines have different arena etiquette. This will be implemented for those designated times
