

FAQ

What are the hours of operation? 8am to 10 pm daily, with the exception of major holidays, events and or clinics. Please refer to our events calendar before you haul.

How do I get an access code to enter the arena? Door codes will be given to those who purchase a monthly, 3 month, 5 month or punch card. Codes will change on the 1st of every month. Those who have valid passes for that month will be given a new code.

Are helmets required to ride? Helmets for riders 12 and under are mandatory. For everyone else, helmets are highly recommended but not required.

Is an Agricultural Society membership required to ride? Yes, for those 18 and older. Under 18 years of age is not required to have a Ag Society Membership.

Do I need to make an appointment to ride or can I just show up?

If you hold a valid riding pass, you may show up during operating business hours. Drop ins and walk in may show up during discipline hours only (refer to event calendar). If you would like to show up outside of discipline hours, please contact Casey to make arrangements.

What are your fees? Please refer to our fee schedule

If I go to a discipline night, am I required to participate in that discipline? No, but please be mindful of those that are and adhere to that disciplines arena adequate.

I am a jumper and/or dressage rider, how come I have no discipline night? When we consulted this subject with the jumpers and dressage riders in the area. It was determined that a specific time block every week was not realistic to be able to attend. Instead, we will offer a one free 2hr private booking per week for this discipline. This must be booked a min of 3 days
