Share a glimpse into Fairview's past with antique machinery, a restored school house, log homes, a recent Trinity Lutheran Church addition, cabins, as well as other historical commercial buildings available for viewing.

The Marshall Rolling Exhibits Building, located on the site also has a large collection of archival material.

The Fairview Pioneer Museum is located just one kilometre north of Fairview on secondary highway 732, turning east at the Cummings Lake turnoff.
